The final program of the conference will be handed to the participants at the registration desk during the conference.

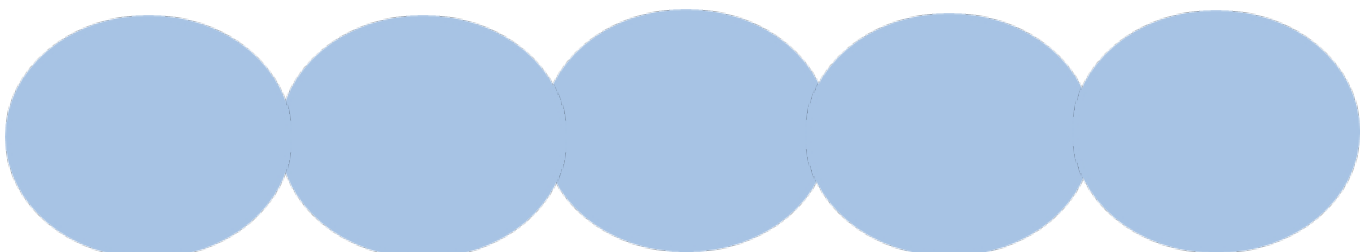
Travel information:
